



## **CBP Form 7553**

# **Notice of Intent to Export, Destroy, or Return Merchandise for Purposes of Drawback Instructions**

1. Enter complete name, address, and federal ID number (EIN) of exporter or destroyer of goods as applicable.
2. Enter original drawback entry number for goods when imported.
3. Specify if goods are to be either destroyed or exported.
4. Specify intended date of action for either destruction or export.
5. Enter name of drawback center originally assigned by customs.
6. Enter all contact name identification information.
7. Specify physical location of the merchandise.
8. Specify method of destruction if applicable and physical location where action is to take place.
9. Enter name of exporting carrier if goods are to be exported instead of destroyed.
10. Specify the intended port of export if goods will not be destroyed.
11. Enter any assigned identifier number.
12. Enter the Transportation and Entry Bond number if one has been assigned.
13. Enter the country of ultimate destination of the goods to be exported.
14. Enter the original customs entry number assigned on importation.
15. Specify complete description of the goods to be either destroyed or exported including part numbers if applicable.
16. Enter the dollar amount of drawback claimed.
17. Specify the quantity and unit of measure of the goods.
18. Specify the Harmonized Tariff Schedule number of the goods for import and/or the Schedule B number for export.
19. Specify the type of drawback being claimed.
20. To be signed and completed by the person preparing the form.
