

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE MULTIMODAL DANGEROUS GOODS FORM

1. Enter the name and address of the shipper.
2. Enter the transport document number assigned by the carrier or control number if applicable for military shipments.
3. Enter the number of pages or "page 1 of 1" if one page only.
4. Enter the shipper's reference number or control number.
5. Enter the freight forwarder's reference or control number if applicable.
6. Enter the full name and address of the consignee (recipient).
7. Carrier identification to be entered by the carrier or forwarder.
8. Delete either "Passenger and Cargo Aircraft" or "Cargo Aircraft" to indicate if the shipment is packed to comply with the limitations prescribed for air mode transport equipment.
9. Enter any additional handling information required by the regulations or applicable to the dangerous properties of the goods being shipped.
10. Specify the Vessel name or Aircraft flight number and date of departure.
11. Specify the port or place of loading of the cargo on the vessel or aircraft.
12. Specify the city or port of cargo unloading or discharge.
13. Enter the final destination of the cargo.
14. Enter the descriptive information for each separate item shipped.

In the following order, enter the number and kind of packages, "UN Number", proper shipping name, hazard class or division number, Packing Group and any

additional shipping description information, if required (e.g., flash point, if required; Marine Pollutant notation, if required; LTD QTY notation, if required; etc.) of each commodity. Gross weight in kilograms, net weight in kilograms and package size in cubic meters.

15. Enter the container identification number for containerized freight or vehicle identification number for rolling stock, as applicable.
16. Enter the container security seal number or numbers for multiple container consignments.
17. Enter the container size in length or vehicle size and type, as applicable.
18. Enter the tare (shipping container or packaging) weight.
19. Enter the total weight of the shipment in kilograms including tare weight in kilograms.
20. For container shipments, specify the name of the company, name and status, place and date, and signature of the person responsible for packing / loading the container.
21. Shipment receipt to be signed by consignee or consignee's agent at the delivery location and the driver to sign at the pickup location.
22. Enter the shipper's company name, the name and status, place and date, and signature of the person completing the dangerous goods form.
