

Certificate of Origin for South Africa (South Africa Revenue Service Form DA59) Instructions

1. Enter the name and complete address of the exporter / shipper of the goods.
2. Enter the name and complete address of the consignee (recipient) of the goods being shipped.
3. Specify the mode, carrier name, and waybill number of the shipment.
4. Leave blank. For customs use.
5. Indicate the line item number.
6. Specify any marks or numbers on the packaging.
7. Enter the quantity, units of measure, and packaging used.
8. Enter the description of the goods.
9. Specify the country of origin of the goods. This will be the country of manufacture or production.
10. Enter the gross weight and/or cubic dimensions of the packaging.
11. Specify the invoice number referenced on the commercial invoice .
12. Complete the certification section to include name, place of signing, date of signing, and signature of the person completing the form.
