Certificate of Origin - U.S. / Singapore

Free Trade Agreement Instructions

1. Enter the name, address, and federal tax identification number (EIN) of the exporter of the goods.

2. Specify the dates of effectiveness of the blanket certificate of origin period if applicable (up to one year).

3. Enter the name, address, and tax ID number of the producer of the goods. The producer is the manufacturer of the finished goods being exported or the processor, mine, farm, etc. if raw materials are being exported.

4. Enter name, address, and tax identification number of the importer of the goods located in the destination country of the shipment.

5. Enter the description of the goods or material being exported in the shipment.

6. Enter the Harmonized Tariff System Classification Number applicable to the commodity or goods on each line (first six digits only).

7. Specify the applicable preference criterion U.S. / Singapore Free Trade Agreement Rules of Origin:

B-1 if wholly obtained or produced entirely in the territory of Singapore or of the United States, or both;

B-2 if goods that, in their condition as imported, are enumerated in subdivision (m) of General Note 25 of the *Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States* and imported from the territory of Singapore; or

B-3 have been transformed in the territory of Singapore or of the United States, or both, so that each nonoriginating material has undergone the required

tariff change or other applicable requirement of the free trade agreement.

8. Indicate the name of the producer of the goods.

9. If not subject to Regional Value Content rule, state "No." If subject to RVC, state "Buildup" or "Builddown" depending on which method was used.

10. Specify the country of origin (country of manufacture or production) of the goods being exported which will be "US" or "SN".

11. Sign and date the applicable blocks and enter all shipper identification information as required in blocks 11a. through 11f.
