# Certificate of Origin for Japan Instructions

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1. Enter the document number assigned by the applicant (exporter).
2. Enter the complete name and address of the applicant (exporter).
3. Specify any marks or numbers for the packages containing the goods or materials being shipped.
4. Specify the number of packages for each item.
5. Enter the place of origin (country of origin of manufacture or production) of each item shipped.
- 6a. Enter the quantity (number and units of measure).
- 6b. Enter the description of the commodities being shipped.
7. Enter the value as specified on the commercial invoice for customs purposes.
8. Complete all required information in the certification section.
9. This certification section to be completed by the exporters Chamber of Commerce.
