



IMPORTERS SECURITY FILINGS (ISF)

CBP announced on June 16, 2010 that all shipments that are not filed on a timely basis consistent with ISF regulations will be subject to a full Customs examination upon arrival into the U.S.

CBP stated that the current process of enforcement is at a 10% examination for all **ISF untimely and non-compliant filings**. CBP advises that the number of physical intensive examinations will increase to a 50% rate by 8/1/2010.

CBP also noted that importers who are certified / validated under the C-TPAT program, may face C-TPAT suspension for ISF violations which will be deemed as a ***“breach of security commitment”***.
